[2025 IDAHO LEGISLATURE ADJOURNS SINE DIE](#)

We started last week on March 31 wondering how long the legislature might remain in Boise. By mid-week, we had reached the point that it appeared they could wrap up, but the rumors indicated at least one remaining week longer in April.

However, things began to change quickly on Thursday late afternoon and leading into Friday morning. The House adjourned for the year around 3:46 p.m. Friday, April 4. The Senate adjourned shortly thereafter at 4:40 p.m. in a motion met with applause.

The past several years lawmakers have opted to recess for five days to wait and see if the governor will veto any legislation, which gives them the option to override the veto. This year, lawmakers opted to end the session until 2026, unless the governor or enough lawmakers agree to call a special session.

NOTE: There are bills that are on the Governor's desk awaiting his consideration. As soon as we have final closure to all the bills we have been monitoring, we will produce an end of the Session Summary Report for all the AMG clients.
